2019 MANDATORY NATURE AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE INFORMATION

The National Institute for Statistics and Census is the technical governing body of national statistics and coordinator of the National Statistical System (NSS). Said capacity was vested under the National Statistical System Act (Law No. 7839 of November 4, 1998), which was enacted in consideration of the importance of having appropriate and updated statistical data for establishing economic and social policies.

This law further sets out the obligation to provide any necessary data to produce national statistics and the confidentiality thereof:

Section 4: "... Any data collected in accordance with this law shall be deemed strictly confidential... Data from private natural or legal persons shall not be disclosed or published individually, but rather as part of overall figures, except as otherwise authorized –in advance– by the party who disclosed the information. To that extent, figures pertaining to three or more natural or legal persons shall be considered overall figures. Moreover, such information shall not be disclosed for any tax purposes or otherwise..."

Section 5: "The NSS may request information from all natural and legal persons based in Costa Rica that relates to their activity..."
